Circle Left

Mr. Postman, look and see, if there's a letter in your bag for me Left Allemande, Turn the Partner by the Right, Left Allemande gonna Weave tonight. There must be some word today, from my boyfriend so far away,

Please Mr. Postman, look and see, if there's a letter, a letter for me.

Figure: Twice for Heads and Twice for Sides
Heads(sides) promenade, take it half you go,
Down the middle, Square Thru and go four,
Go all the way Touch a ¼, my friend, Scoot Back, Boy run again
Pass the Ocean, All 8 Circulate, Swing the corner, Promenade your date,
Please Mr. Postman, look and see, if there's a letter, a letter for me.
(Atlernate lyric: You didn't stop to make me feel better, by leavin' me, a card or a letter.)

Middle Break
Sides Face, Grand Square
(no lyric, guitar solo, musical interlude)
Allemande Left and Weave the ring
I've been standing here waitin' Mr. Postman, so-o-o patiently
For just a card, or just a letter, saying he's returning home to me.

Closer

Sides Face, Grand Square

So many days you passed me by, see the tears standing in my eye

You didn't stop to make me feel better, by leavin' me, Allemande Left and Weave the ring

You've gotta wait a minute, wait a minute

Wait a minute, wait a minute (000-000)

Wait a minute, wait a minute,

Come on deliver the letter, the sooner the better...
