Allemande Left your Corner Lady Weave the Ring When I go out, yeah I know I'm gonna be I'm gonna be the man who goes along with you (Promenade)

When I'm working, yes I know I'm gonna be I'm gonna be the man who's working hard for you

Heads (Sides) You Square Thru, four hands around the ring, Meet the corner lady do a Do Sa Do, (Make a Wave) Swing Thru, Boys Run Right around that girl, Ladies Trade (in the Middle), now Tag The Line Girls Turn Around and Swing, Swing that girl and Promenade the ring, Just to be the man who'd walk a 1,000 miles To fall down at your door Middle Break

(Sides Face, Grand Square)

La La-La-La, La La-La, La La, La La-La-La, La La-La, La La La La La La La La La La,

(Allemande Left and Weave) But I would walk 500 miles

And I would meet my girl and swing Just to be the man who'd walk a 1,000 miles

To fall down at your door

Closer (Circle Left)

\*\*When I come home, oh I know I'm gonna be I'm gonna be the man who comes back home to you Left Allemande Now, You'll Do Sa Do go around Your own Allemande Left your Corner Lady Weave the Ring But I would walk 500 miles And I would walk 500 more Just to be the man who'd walk a 1,000 miles To fall down at your door
